Abstract

Goal progress has been consistently linked to subjective well-being and happiness (Klug & Maier, 2015), but do the individual actions of doing something helpful for personal goals have similar effects? The current study investigates how goal alignment—the perception that you are engaging in activities that are aligned with personal goals—might be associated with state happiness. We hypothesized that people will feel happier when the activities they are performing are aligned with their goals. The study also explored the roles of goal progress and competence in this relation. Data on goal-activity alignment, goal progress, competence, and state happiness were collected in an experience-sampling study with undergraduate students ( $N = 159$ ) and a survey study with Amazon MTurk workers ( $N = 252$ ). Using multilevel analyses and regression analyses, results indicated that participants were happier when they were pursuing activities that were more closely aligned with their goals than when pursuing less goal-aligned activities; the results remained significant after accounting for goal progress. Participants who were more goal aligned on average reported greater state happiness; this effect was nonsignificant when goal progress was accounted for. Results suggest that goal alignment has a significant and unique effect on state happiness and that goal pursuit has very immediate benefits that begin as soon as individuals start doing actions helpful for their personal goals. 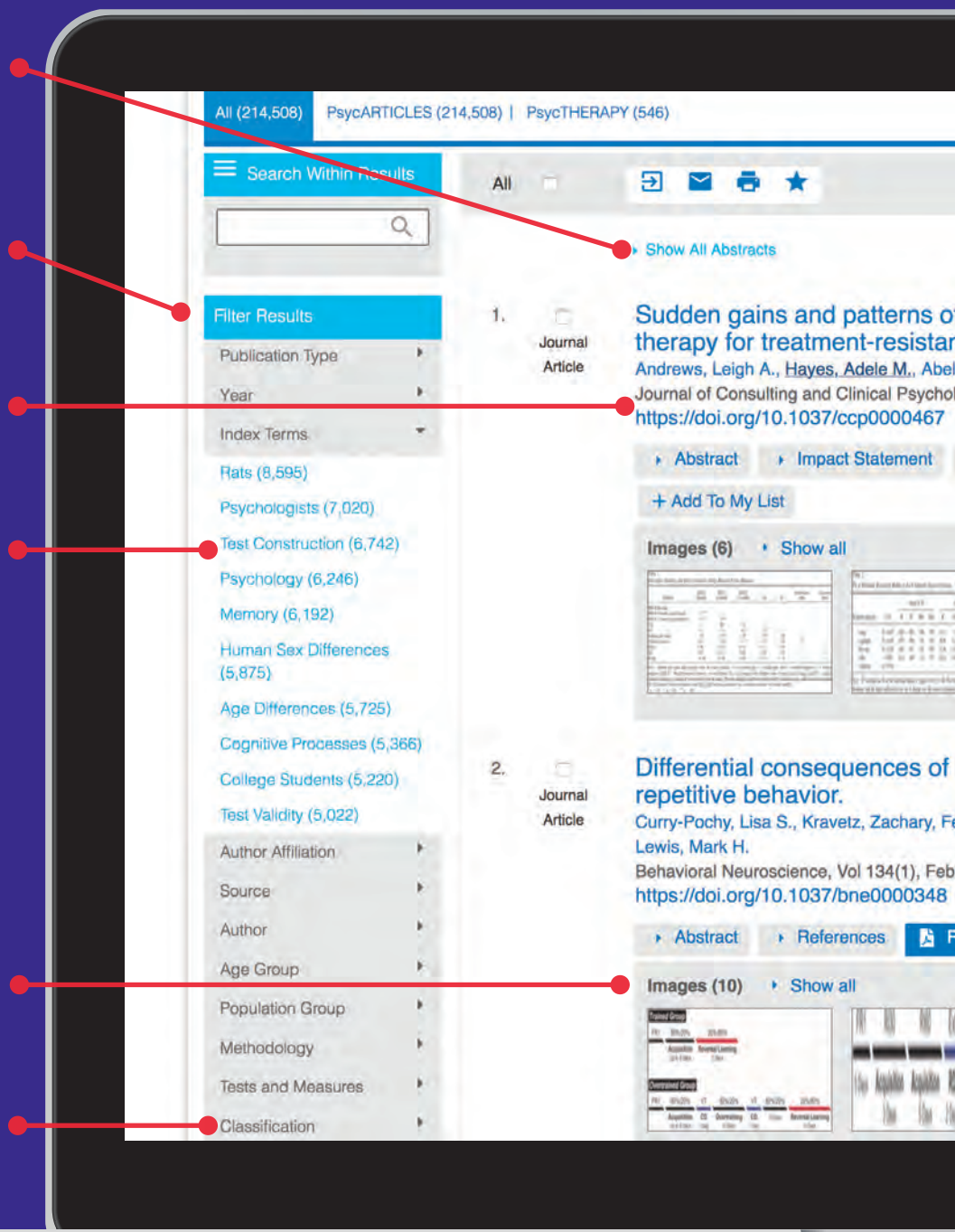

### Abstract

Romantic passion typically declines over time, but a downward trajectory is not inevitable. Across 3 studies (1 of which encompassed 2 substudies), we investigated whether creativity helps bolster romantic passion in established relationships. Studies 1A and 1B revealed that people with highly creative personalities report not only greater overall passion but also an attenuation in the tendency for passion to decline as relationship duration increases. Studies 2 and 3 explored positive illusions about the partner's physical attractiveness as a possible mediator of the effect of creativity on passion. Cross-lagged panel analyses in Study 2 indicated that being creative is linked to a tendency to view the partner as especially attractive, even relative to the partner's own self-assessment. Path analyses in Study 3 provided longitudinal evidence consistent with the hypothesis that positive illusions about the partner's attractiveness (participant's assessments, controlling for objective coding of the partner's attractiveness) mediate the link between creativity and changes in passion over time. Study 3 also provided longitudinal evidence of the effect of creativity on passion trajectories over time, an effect that emerged not only for self-reported passion but also for coded passion during a laboratory-based physical intimacy task 9 months later. A meta-analytic summary across studies indicated a significant overall main effect of creativity on passion, as well as a significant moderation effect of creativity on risks of decline (e.g., relationship length).

Purpose	The purpose of the Selected Dream Theories Measure is to assess agreement with selected dream theories regarding dream functions.
Description	<p>The Selected Dream Theories Measure (Olsen, Schredl, &amp; Carlsson, 2016) was constructed in the context of a study examining differences in dream attitude with respect to age, educational level, and sex. People and dream functions were investigated in terms of selected dream theories. This measure was applied to English-speaking people (aged 10-&gt; 60 years) on Facebook, as well as to university students. Agreement representing major prescientific and scientific dream functions, based on dream function overview literature, was assessed. All items were rated using a five-point scale (strongly disagree) to 5 (strongly agree). 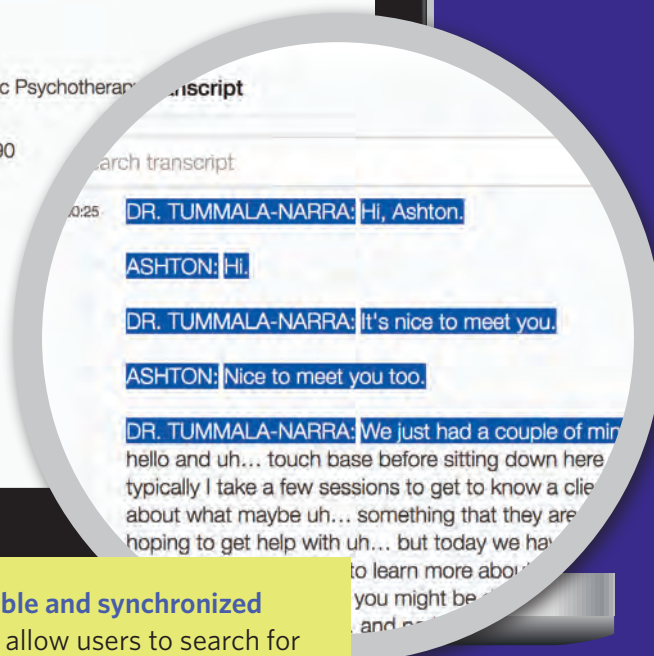

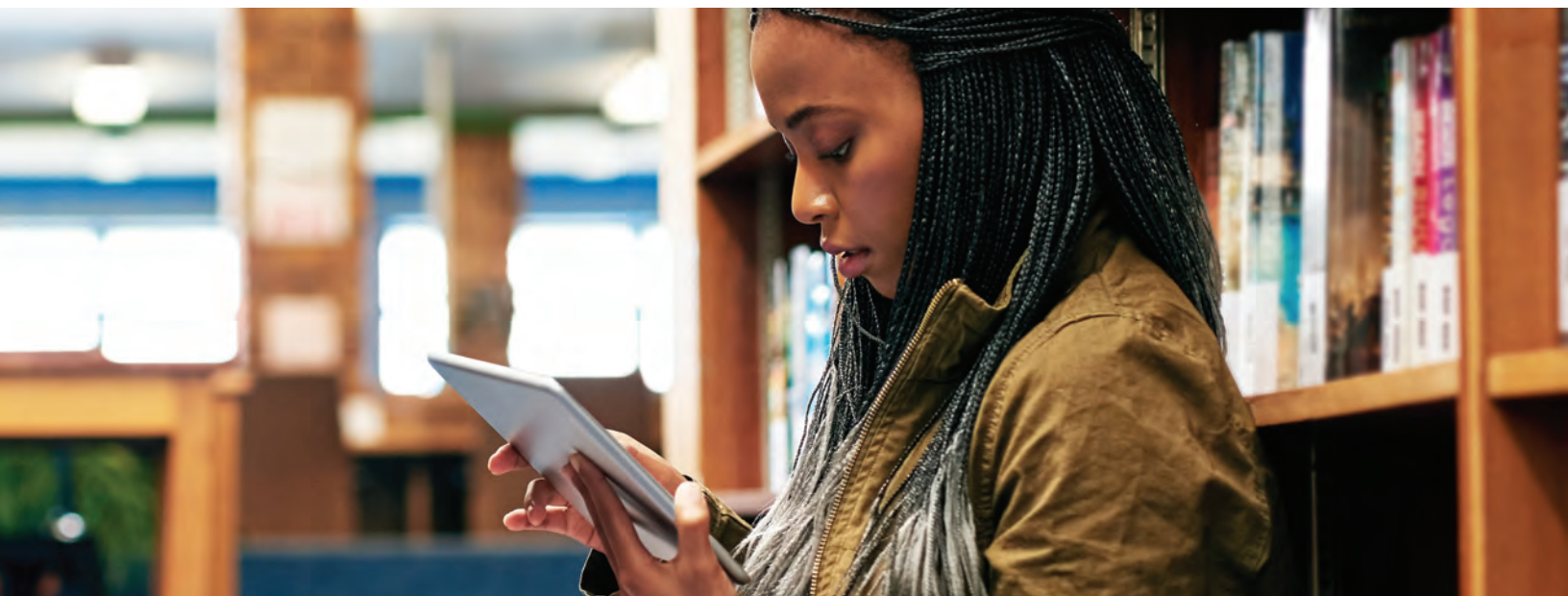
