All corporate contributions to the ACOS-PAC will be used for educational and administrative fees of ACOS-PAC and other activities permissible under federal law. **Federal law requires the ACOS-PAC to use its best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and the name of the employer of individuals whose contributions exceed \$200 in a calendar year. The ACOS-PAC is a program of the ACOS, which is exempt from federal income tax under section 501c (6) of the Internal Revenue Code.
