AAPA's CME Accreditation

AAPA is the only accrediting body of AAPA Category 1 CME. As of 2022, the previous limit of 20 AAPA Category 1 CME for preceptors is no longer in effect. Preceptors may now earn an unlimited number of AAPA Category 1 CME for their precepting efforts from programs accredited by AAPA to provide these CME. Preceptorship CME is earned at a rate of 2 AAPA Category 1 CME credits per PA student per 40-hour week.
