StoryWalk® is an innovative way to combine physical activity with literacy. Pages of a book have been transformed into signs that are laid out on a trail inviting families, children, caregivers, and others to follow the path.

This StoryWalk® features “Farmers & Ranchers Care about their Animals”, written by Dan Yunk and donated by the farmers and ranchers of Dickinson County Farm Bureau Assn. For this Storywalk®, we are pleased to work with businesses in Herington who have agreed to post storyboards in their windows from July 13th-18th. The StoryWalk® starts at the Herington Library and follows a path from business to business, ending at Central National Bank (see map above).

At the end of the StoryWalk® participants are asked to answer a few questions about their experience. This can be done using a QR code with your cell phone, by visiting our survey link posted on the final page of the StoryWalk®, or by completing a sheet inside the library during normal business hours. Participants who complete the discussion questions have their names entered into a drawing for 1-2 lbs of high quality Kansas raised ground beef provided by Agri Dime, a local beef supply chain management company that partners with Morgan Creek Farms and other local producers. The cost of the meat is paid for by farmers and ranchers of Dickinson County Farm Bureau Assn. Vouchers will be mailed to participants of StoryWalk® and the meat can be picked up at Barnes Heartland Grocery Store. Questions about our StoryWalk® can be directed to dickinsonfb@kfb.org.
