

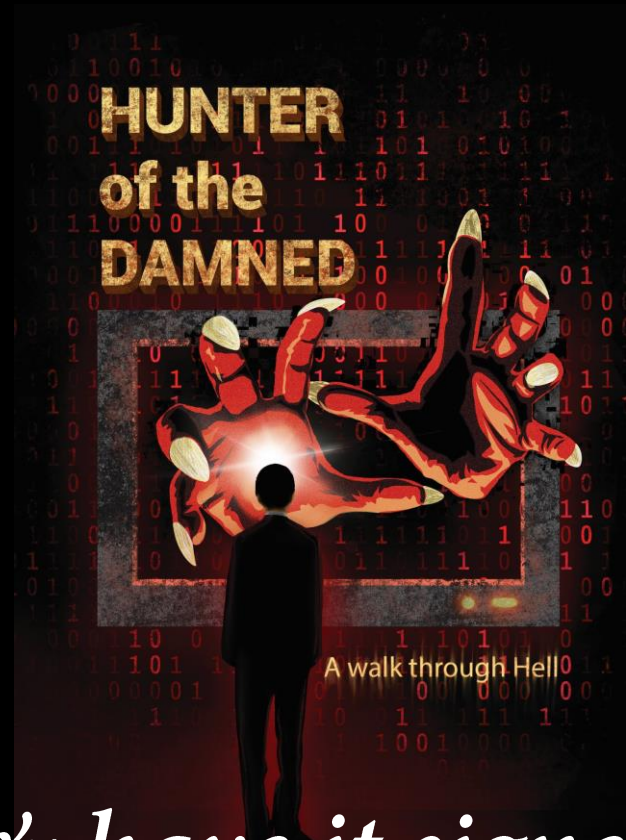
Hunter of the Dammed: A walk through Hell
